McBride Dale Clarion is working with the City of Grandview Heights, Ohio on an update to the city's 1997 Community Plan. The Community Plan update process is being run concurrently with the creation of a Civic Spaces and Places Plan (led by urban design firm, NBBJ). This will ensure that the recommendations from both plans are aligned and cohesive. The initial phases of both planning efforts were seamlessly integrated to ensure the creation

of a common set of vision and goals that will guide both plans.

The process has provided various opportunities for the community to be engaged, ranging from in-person presentations and workshops to online surveys and feedback boards. The Community Plan update is also being guided by a steering committee of community stakeholders. The plan is organized around a series of themes which include: land use

and character, transportation and connectivity, economic health, and environment and resiliency. Each theme has a unique goal, set of objectives, and clear implementation strategies for achieving the city's desired results.
